General Notes:

- This scenario is **not** intended for orchards or timber plantations.
- Site tree selections must be approved by Rolling Hills Staff.
- The site plan must be approved by Rolling Hills Staff.
- Tree planting instructions will be given at time of planting
- Trees **must be protected** from livestock damage by either electric fencing, t posts and wire, or wire tree cages.
- Plantra Tree tubes will be supplied by Rolling Hills and used no matter what tree species or tree protection method is chosen.
- The landowner will be responsible for tree care and maintenance during the program at no additional costs to Rolling Hills of NRCS.
- A signed contract must be in place prior to beginning the process.
- Rolling Hills and NRCS will provide technical assistance if needed during the program.
- Tree costs will be capped per tree planted.
- Rolling Hills and NRCS will determine the best course of action for trees that die during the program.

Trees recommended for Program:

Silvopasture Trees Recommended. Tree choices will have to be approved for Planting Zone and soil conditions were planted. Oaks can cause issues in grazing animals and are recommended for well-established pastures where they will not be primary food source.
